

Terms and Conditions Brainclinics Education

1.1 Participation

The participant is expected to have at least a Masters grade in Human Sciences (e.g. Psychology, Medicine). In cases where the education level is comparable, participation can be considered by Brainclinics. Brainclinics can request degrees and certificates as proof.

1.2 Payments

The registration fee will have to be paid within 30 days after the invoice date and in any case 14 days before the start of the course or workshop. When these payment terms are not met, Brainclinics retains the right to exclude the participant from the course or workshop.

Brainclinics obtains the right to change the price of courses and workshops if necessary.

During the courses and workshops Brainclinics will serve coffee, tea, fruit juice and a lunch.

1.3 Cancellation

Cancellation of the registration need to be communicated in an e-mail, which will be confirmed by Brainclinics. For cancellations more than 30 days before the start of the first course or workshop day, there will no costs involved. For cancellations within 30 days before start of the first course- or workshop-day, 50% of the course costs will be invoiced. After the start of the course or workshop, cancellation is not possible. In all cases – after consulting Brainclinics – a replacement can be admitted if that person can fulfill requirement 1.1 of these Terms and Conditions.

1.4 Termination

Restitution of the registration fee is only possible when termination of the course or workshop is caused by an unforeseen event such as illness or emergency. Adjudication will be reviewed by Brainclinics.

1.5 Accreditation

Accreditation of the different courses and workshops will be issued by the authoritative body. If accreditation is acknowledged it will be mentioned during the course or workshop. A certificate will be provided after completion of the course or workshop.

1.6 Examination

If a course needs to be completed with an exam performed by Brainclinics, this is a mandatory part of the course. A Brainclinics course can be reviewed by a written or oral examination, a practical assignment or a combination of these.

1.7 Meetings

Brainclinics obtains the right to cancel the course or workshop if there are not enough participants for the course or workshop. Payments that have already been done will be returned. Brainclinics can't be held responsible for other costs (e.g. flight or hotel) caused by the cancellation of courses or workshops. Brainclinics obtains the right to change the program whenever this is required.

1.8 Course material

The copyright and ownership on all course materials developed by Brainclinics will remain of Brainclinics. It is not allowed to multiply, copy or otherwise distribute any of these materials or publish it by press, copy, microfilm or otherwise without the written permission from Brainclinics.

1.9 Complaints
